# MATTHEW 10:1-4

- Matt. 28:16-20, “go” with authority from Jesus and power of the Holy Spirit

# PRAYER AND HEALING

- Jesus is the miracle, healing is the demonstration that miracles still happen
- Healing is not curing
  - Healing is spiritual and internal
  - Curing is external and temporary

# SPIRITUAL HEALING

- Nadine Carter, could not pray “The Lord’s Prayer” because “Father” was a terrible word
- Root of bitterness—can defile many, Heb. 12:15

# RELATIONAL HEALING: GOD

1. Born of the Spirit—1<sup>st</sup> time
2. Return home--renew
3. Ready for more-deeper surrender and greater filling of the Holy Spirit

# RELATIONAL HEALING: SELF

1. Child of God
2. Unique purpose
3. Natural growth or arrested development

# RELATIONAL HEALING: OTHERS

1. Love
2. Spirit
3. Give life
4. Grow

# HEALING: WHEN WE ASK OR PRAY

- Yes—immediate
- Yes—progressive (see people as trees walking)
- Wait— “use it” for God
- Not here → healing thru death and resurrection
